Website

We are happy to allow you permission to use content from our website under the following guidelines.

Using Maori Postal Aotearoa Web Content – General Guidelines

- Provide the content for free.
- Make no changes to the content.
- Credit the content to Maori Postal Aotearoa.
- Cite the copyright information (e.g. copyright Maori Postal Aotearoa. All rights reserved. Used by permission.).
- Cite the source by providing the Web address (www.maoripostal.co.nz).

Posting Maori Postal Aotearoa Web Content on Your Website

- Link to the article on the Maori Postal Aotearoa website (preferred), or,
- Post it in accordance with the General Guidelines and include this message on every page of posted content: “This article originally appeared here at Maori Postal Aotearoa.”
 - Make the word “here” link to the specific URL where the content lives.
 - Make the words “Maori Postal Aotearoa” link to the www.maoripostal.co.nz homepage.

Distributing Maori Postal Aotearoa Web Content

Distribution in print (newsletter, bulletin, tract, etc.) or in an email is permissible, provided it’s in accordance with the General Usage Requirements.

Using Maori Postal Aotearoa Web Transcripts

Since many of our transcripts have not been subjected to our editorial process, usage permission is extended as follows:

- You may use any transcript from Maori Postal Aotearoa in accordance with the guidelines stated above.
- If you desire to use transcripts that are not in the Multimedia section, send us an email to request specific permission (info@maoripostal.co.nz).

Audio

Maori Postal Aotearoa is the official repository of all of audio material. We want to maximize your flexibility in sharing the messages while simultaneously maintaining quality control and connecting people with our ministry. Please partner together with us by observing the following guidelines:

You may duplicate and distribute Maori Postal Aotearoas audio messages in CD and MP3 format without prior permission as long as you follow the restrictions outlined below.

1. You may duplicate and distribute only full-length versions of the messages.
2. You may not edit the content in any way.
3. You may not charge for the material (even to recoup your costs).
4. You may link to messages at Maori Postal Aotearoas website, but you may not post them on your own website.
5. If you copy material to a CD, please include the following information on the CD:

6. You may not include personal or organizational contact information on any CDs.
7. You may not use or reproduce the Maori Postal Aotearoa logo for any purpose.
